This letter confirms that the Ohio Department of Education, Office for Exceptional Children (ODE/OEC) has **received and approved** your application for registration as a private provider for the Autism Scholarship Program. Approval to operate as a registered private provider for the 2009-2010 school year will be effective from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.

In the event you discontinue providing services to children who are participating in the Autism Scholarship Program, you are required to notify, in writing, the Ohio Department of Education, Office for Exceptional Children. ODE shall revoke the registration of any registered private provider determined to be in violation of Ohio Administrative Code Rules 3301-103-01 through 3301-103-08 or in violation of any guidelines established by the ODE for the Autism Scholarship Program.
