*SAIL* is a researched based program serving families with toddlers, preschool, kindergarten, elementary, and middle school age youth diagnosed with educational autism and with the autism spectrum disorder (ASD).

**Every SAIL child has an exceptionally trained and skilled SAIL instructor!!!** Every SAIL child has wrap-around therapies, *i.e., Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Therapy [individualized and Modified], Fine and Oral-Motor-Planned Activities, Speech-Language-Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Sensory Integration Therapy, Gross Motor Planned Activities, Small Instructional Groups, Music Therapy, and Art Therapy.* The goal of *SAIL* is to strive to provide individualized developmental instruction to children across the spectrum of autism as suggested by the **National Academy of Sciences, National Research Council.**

As stated by the **2002 National Research Council** ~ best practices for children with autism are *holistic, early, and intensive interventions* ~ **reflected and implemented by SAIL.**

SAIL offers support for siblings, families, and extended families. *SAIL's* children are primarily visual and tactile learners with accompanying auditory, vestibular, and proprioceptive support.

*The mission of S.A.I.L. is to provide individualized and daily documented developmental instructional methodologies and behavioral techniques with related therapies, viz., Speech Language Therapy, ABA Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Sensory Integration Therapy, Art Therapy, and Music Therapy, all recommended by the National Academy of Sciences, National Research Council. (Lord, 2002)*

**S.A.I.L. Mission:** actualizing full inclusion with age-appropriate-typical peers in a typical setting.

## **S.A.I.L., Inc. Philosophy Statement**

*The philosophy of S.A.I.L. is to enhance the maximum growth of every S.A.I.L. child -ONE-ONE- in the cognitive, sensory, social, affective-emotional, physical, functional language-communication, and aesthetic domains. S.A.I.L. children typically present with neurologically based affective, cognitive, and behavioral differences primarily effecting perceptive, receptive and expressive communication. Most SAIL children have intra/inter-affective and sensory self-regulation issues.*

**S.A.I.L. Philosophy:** supports awareness and ultimate emergence of a child's spirit and personhood while providing multidimensional programming for intrinsic and extrinsic skill development within the *actualization of independence, i.e., cognitive and behavioral choices.*

Very young children with a medical diagnosis of autism OR children suspected to demonstrate autism spectrum disorders (ASD) are also served by S.A.I.L.*

*S.A.I.L. offers full year ~ full day ~ one-to-one educational and related services to every child enrolled in S.A.I.L. **The ODE-ASD Scholarship pays the full tuition - Parents pay no tuition!***

*~ S.A.I.L. Inc. offers Intensive Early Intervention and Inclusion Services at the Pre-K, K, elementary, and middle school levels of education. As a child exhibits minimal behavioral criteria, s/he is merged with typical children complimenting each S.A.I.L. child's innate potential. S.A.I.L. Instructors support each child constantly and consistently ~ one-one. Daily written and individualized child performance and curriculum analyses are documented and relayed to each child's family via the STAR and the TIDES - see drop down forms at [www.SAILOHIO.org](http://www.SAILOHIO.org)*

*S.A.I.L. children receive the following therapies: Speech and Language Therapy, ABA Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Sensory Integration Therapy, Music Therapy and small group art therapy. Dr. Boss and three additional Ph.D. level special educators serve as S.A.I.L., Autism Consultants are involved with the diverse members of the S.A.I.L. Behavioral and Educational Services Team (B.E.S.T.) for each child enrolled in S.A.I.L.*
